We invite you to participate in our Annual Historic Preservation Awards Program to be held on Wednesday, May 23, 2018 at 5:00 pm at the Lincoln Center Hearing Room.

The home/building that is being nominated must be at least 50 years old. Homes/buildings which are identified as contributing properties in any of Manchester's National Register of Historic Districts will receive additional consideration. The nominated property should exhibit efforts to preserve or restore architectural features and characters emblematic of the original architectural style and construction of the building.
