

## LET'S CRUISE!

### **18<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL CRUISIN' ON MAIN STREET PRESENTED BY TAYLOR RENTAL PARTY PLUS OF MANCHESTER AND FUELED BY CITGO**

**Manchester, CT** Cruisin' on Main Street is back to celebrate its 18<sup>th</sup> year of bringing together vintage vehicles, collector car enthusiasts and car lovers of all ages on Sunday, August 5th (Rain dates - Aug. 12 and Aug. 19). Show car registration opens at 8AM. The show opens to spectators from 10AM to 3PM.

Historic Downtown Manchester expects to welcome over 800 vintage vehicles including **antique and classic cars, trucks, sports cars and street rods 1987 and prior only for this one day cruise and show**. A one-mile stretch of Main Street in the Downtown transforms into a plaza-like viewing area where attendees can stroll the street and enjoy 360 degree viewing of the vehicles on display. Vehicles hail from CT and surrounding states.

For the second year the Gear Head Mafia Car Club partners with Cruisin' to put on the event, handling show car registration and parking, assisting with trophy selection and holding a **free Hot Wheels Racing Contest for kids**.

Attendees can expect to enjoy:

**Diverse and Informative Sponsor Displays** - Over 46 businesses have stepped forward to sponsor Cruisin' on Main Street 2018, led by Presenting Sponsor, Taylor Rental Party Plus of Manchester and Fueled by CITGO Fueling Good. With the addition of new show car parking areas this year, the one mile length of Main Street and abutting parking lots provide ample room for both show car and sponsor displays.

Special Interest Vehicles and a Robot offering fun photo ops – Everyone enjoys seeing and photo sharing special interest vehicles. Example of photo friendly vehicles appearing this year are The Gear Head Mafia Zombie Patrol Truck – the Beast, the Foxwoods Resort Casino 301 Pace Car from the New Hampshire Motor Speedway and, “Shuri” the robot created by the he Ethel Walker School girls high school robotics team, the Wirecats.

Music from one end of Main Street to the other – The Full Power Radio family of stations will bring three of its premier stations to the street including: 102.9 The Whale, 1360 Talk of CT and Radio 104.1. Along with DJ Dale “In the Groove”, the Northeast Surf Music Alliance and DJ Kevin Crane, the street will offer many music venues and options.

Tours of Manchester's Mill History – The Manchester Historical Society will operate a shuttle from the corner of Forest St. and Main St. that will allow show attendees to take a short excursion to the Manchester History Center. Visitors can see the Loom Exhibit, the Machine Shop of the Cheney Silk Manufacturing Company and many other interesting historical artifacts. The shuttle will be available from 10:30AM to 2:30PM.

Delicious food – from a great array of street vendors and the diverse restaurants along Main Street. Taken together there will be over 37 choices of great eats from the Elks Black Angus Burgers to Manchester’s new Ethiopian Restaurant, Walia.

**Cruisin’ Shopping** - Spectators are encouraged to visit Downtown shops and stop-in at the Cruisin’ Bazaar located in the Forest Street Parking Lot.

**The Official 2018 Cruisin’ T-Shirt and Baseball Caps**– This year’s official Cruisin’ T-shirt features a 1952 red Ford pick-up truck owned by David Armata of Hebron. T-shirts will sell for \$15. New Cruisin’ Baseball caps in navy blue and embroidered with the colorful Cruisin’ on Main logo will be offered for the first time. Baseball cap cost is \$12. Both t-shirts and the baseball caps will be sold at the show by volunteers from Key Bank and the energetic members of the Manchester High School Cheer Squad.

### **FUELING LOCAL CHARITIES**

## **HOW TO GET THERE & WHERE TO PARK**

Getting to Cruisin' on Main Street is easy. Take I-84 to I-384 to Exit 3 to Downtown Manchester or approach Main Street via U.S. Routes 6 and 44. Follow the signs for show car entry or spectator parking.

Handicapped parking is located in the enclosed parking lot at the rear of Webster Bank on the corner of Main and Maple Streets. Wheelchair accessible van parking is located in the lot next to the Manchester Fires-Rescue-EMS Station at 75 Center St.
