The Connecticut Department of Public Health is updating its State Health Assessment, which is a document that helps shape future health policy and programming for the state.

As part of this effort, the Department is gathering input from residents about what health issues are priorities for their communities. The online Community Health Priority Survey is anonymous and provides all Connecticut residents the opportunity to share their opinions about community needs, as well as give them the opportunity to weigh in on where Connecticut should prioritize resources to improve the health of their community.
