

Municipal Election: Tuesday, November 5, 2019.

All 9 Polling places will be open from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm.

Extended Voter Session: Tuesday, October 29, 2019, the Registrars of Voters office at 479 Main Street, 1st floor, will be open from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm. This is the last day to register in-person or have a voter application postmarked before Election Day, which is Tuesday November 5, 2019.

For any Manchester resident not registered by October 29, there will be Election Day voter registration on Tuesday, November 5th from 6:00 am to 8:00 pm, at the Manchester Registrar of Voters office, 479 Main St. Weiss Center, 1st floor. Proper identification showing the resident's address will be required.
