

Manchester's Spruce Street Market Nights

Spruce Street Market Nights will run weekly on Wednesday evenings, June 12 – August 21, 4:30 – 7:30 pm at 153 & 160 Spruce Street. The market will feature live music, open gallery hours, free garden tours and workshops, children's activities, and the opportunity to support local farmers and artisans.

Every week, local farmers and artisans will offer a variety of agricultural products for sale including pasture raised meats, eggs, farm fresh veggies; orchard fresh fruits; along with an array of artisanal goods. The Spruce Street Market accepts cash, credit, debit, WIC, Senior Checks, and SNAP. The market will be offering *CT Fresh Match*, a program that doubles the value of SNAP purchases up to \$10.00, to be spent on additional fresh produce.
