**Manchester, CT** - Rebuilding Together Manchester is accepting applications for 2021 home repair and maintenance projects. We are a non-profit organization that assists low-income Manchester homeowners, specifically the elderly, disabled, and families with children, with maintenance and home repairs that they are unable to manage on their own. The deadline for applications is January 31, 2021.

The work is completed at no cost to the homeowner primarily through volunteer labor. To qualify, the home must be located in Manchester and the applicant *must be the legal owner* of the property. Income verification is required as we can only assist low-income homeowners. Examples of our projects include interior and exterior repairs, accessibility modifications such as installation of grab bars and railings, painting, yard work, and clutter removal. We do have grant funding for roof rehabilitation program and install handicap ramps for those who qualify. If your roof is leaking or needs replacement call for more information.

Our largest annual event, National Rebuilding Day, will take place on April 24th, 2021 however we do emergency repairs and projects on a year-round basis. Sponsorship information will be going out shortly and volunteer opportunities for National Rebuilding Day will be announced in January.
